Eligibility

All Neuk Collective members are eligible to submit **1** piece of work to the exhibition.

Size of Work

Our intention is to accept all work submitted. But we also have to work within the space limitations of the venue. If you are intending to submit work that:

- is more than 1m wide, including frame, for wall-hanging work; or
- is more than 50cm wide x 50 cm deep for 3D work

We encourage smaller pieces where possible!

New vs. Existing Work

We are not able to financially support the creation of new work so **we encourage you to submit existing work** - preferably work that is already complete at the time of submission.

If you have a piece in progress you want to submit, you can, but **it must be complete by 5pm on March 29th.**

Insurance

Artists are responsible for insuring their own work. All works accepted for exhibition will be displayed entirely at the artists' risk and organisers and the gallery will not accept liability for loss or damage occurring during the exhibition.

Delivery and Collection

Work should be delivered to the gallery on either Wednesday 26th June or Thursday 27th June, and be collected on Tuesday 30th July or Wednesday 31st July. Other delivery dates or courier delivery are by negotiation, and whether we can accommodate will depend on the size and weight of the work. Please tell us if you need this option ("Is there anything else you would like to tell us?")

More precise timings to follow.

We are looking at establishing a collection hub in Glasgow - a central place where local artists can drop their work off, for it to be collected and brought to Edinburgh. Please contact us if you can assist with this.

Work not collected at the stated times will be subject to a daily charge of £10 and will be disposed of after one week.
